Weighted Average Life Maturity is the Weighted Average Maturity of the fund calculated without reference to the "maturity shortening" provisions. SEC 30-day yield is based upon dividends per share from net investment income during the past 30 days, divided by the period ended maximum offering price per share and annualized.
