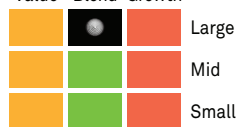

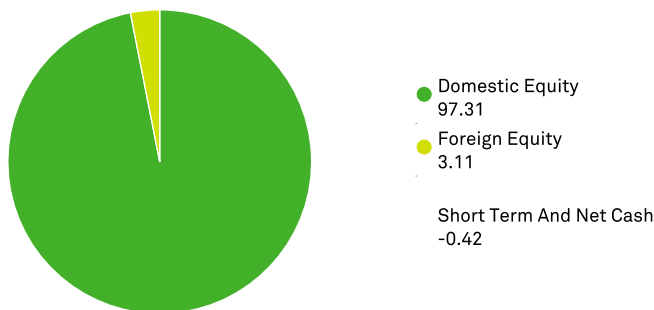

GOAL/APPROACH

The fund seeks to match the performance of the Standard & Poor's 500 Composite Stock Price Index ("S&P 500 Index").

To pursue this goal, the fund generally is fully invested in stocks included in the S&P 500 Index, and in futures whose performance is tied to the S&P 500 Index. The fund attempts to have a correlation between its performance and that of the index of at least .95, before expenses. A correlation of 1.00 would mean that the fund and the S&P 500 Index were perfectly correlated.

The fund generally invests in all 500 stocks in the S&P 500 Index in proportion to their weighting in the S&P 500 Index. The S&P 500 Index is a capitalization-weighted unmanaged index of 500 common stocks chosen to reflect the industries of the U.S. economy and is often considered a proxy for the stock market in general. The fund may also use stock index futures as a substitute for the sale or purchase of securities.

PORTFOLIO MANAGEMENT

The fund's investment adviser is The Dreyfus Corporation (Dreyfus). Thomas J. Durante, Karen Q. Wong and Richard A. Brown are the primary portfolio managers of the fund. Mr. Durante has been a primary portfolio manager of the fund since March 2000. Mr. Durante is a managing director and co-head of equity index portfolio management at BNY

Mellon Asset Management North America Corporation (the "firm"), an affiliate of Dreyfus. Ms. Wong and Mr. Brown have been primary portfolio managers of the fund since June 2010. Ms. Wong is a managing director and head of index portfolio management at the firm, and Mr. Brown is a managing director and co-head of equity index portfolio management at the firm. Ms. Wong and Messrs. Durante and Brown are also employees of Dreyfus. BNY Mellon Asset Management North America Corporation professionals manage Dreyfus-managed funds pursuant to a dual-employee arrangement, under Dreyfus' supervision, and apply their firm's proprietary investment process in managing the funds.

Effective on January 31, 2018, The Boston Company Asset Management LLC (TBCAM) and Standish Mellon Asset Management Company LLC (Standish) merged into Mellon Capital Management Corporation (Mellon Capital), which immediately changed its name to BNY Mellon Asset Management North America Corporation.

The investment objective and policies of Dreyfus Stock Index Fund, Inc., Initial Shares may be similar to those of other funds/portfolios managed or advised by Dreyfus.
