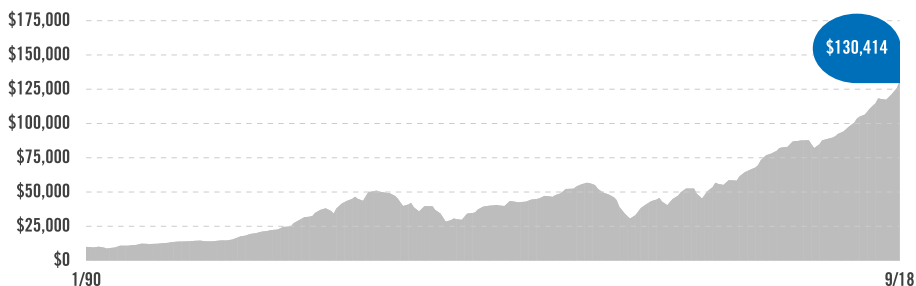

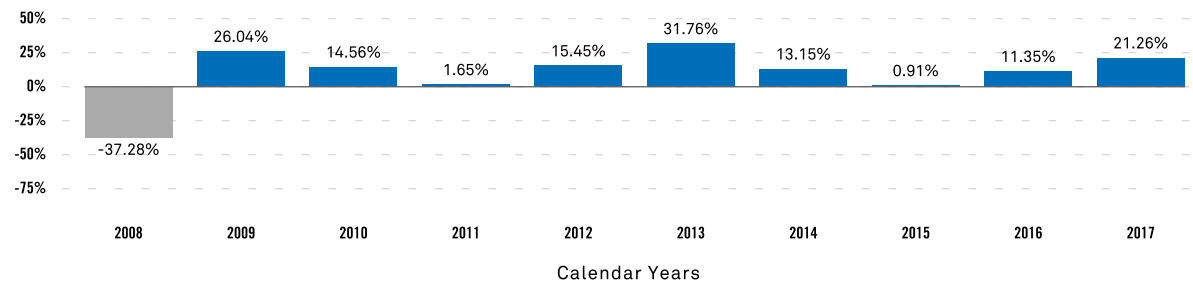
Growth of a \$10,000 Investment

HISTORICAL PERFORMANCE²



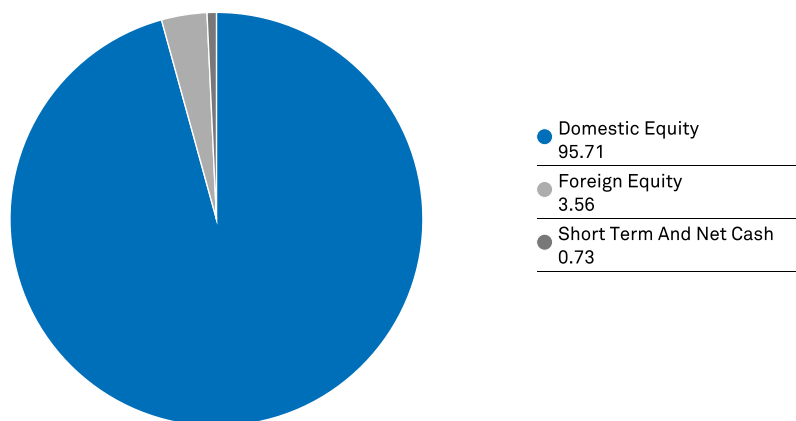

GOAL/APPROACH

The fund seeks to match the performance of the S&P 500® Index. To pursue its goal, the fund generally is fully invested in stocks included in the S&P 500® Index and in futures whose performance is tied to the index. The fund generally invests in all 500 stocks in the S&P 500® Index in proportion to their weighting in the index.

PORTFOLIO MANAGEMENT

The fund's investment adviser is The Dreyfus Corporation (Dreyfus). Thomas J. Durante, Karen Q. Wong and Richard A. Brown are the primary portfolio managers of the fund. Mr. Durante has been a primary portfolio manager of the fund since March 2000. Mr. Durante is a managing director and co-head of equity index portfolio management at BNY Mellon Asset Management North America Corporation (the "firm"), an affiliate of Dreyfus. Ms. Wong and Mr. Brown have been primary portfolio managers of the fund since June 2010. Ms. Wong is a managing director and head of index portfolio management at the firm, and Mr. Brown is a managing director and co-head of equity index portfolio management at the firm. Ms. Wong and Messrs. Durante and Brown are also employees of Dreyfus. BNY Mellon Asset Management North America Corporation professionals manage Dreyfus-managed funds pursuant to a dual-employee arrangement, under Dreyfus' supervision, and apply their firm's proprietary investment process in managing the funds.
